getting ready for the next section

WORK ON THE SECOND SECTION OF HAMILTON'S CITYHEART PROJECT IS SET TO BEGIN, WITH WORK ALONG VICTORIA STREET BETWEEN COLLINGWOOD STREET AND BRYCE STREET PLANNED TO START DURING THE WEEK BEGINNING 23 MARCH.

Based in their ground floor Project Office at 391 Victoria Street, the CityHeart team has been working hard to prepare detailed design and construction drawings, completing exploratory work to locate services and utilities, and generally preparing for the new section of the Victoria Street works.

John Pearman, Project Manager for the CityHeart project team, said, "Work on the section of Victoria Street between Hood Street and Collingwood Street has gone well and we are now keen to start work on the second section of the project, to the north of Collingwood Street. We plan to start construction in the week of 23th March and progress northwards along Victoria Street up to the limit of the works, at Bryce Street. Completion of the work is programmed for the

end of June. As with the first section of the work we aim to keep the Victoria Street businesses and the public informed every step of the way. We will do this by:

- being easily contactable, our project office is at 391 Victoria Street – next to Breakers Café/bar – open Monday-Friday 8.30am-5pm
- regular briefing meetings with those most affected
- regular information drops and strategically placed public notice boards along Victoria Street, including at the Project Office"

Businesses and property owners will be updated through regular, weekly meetings and face to face interviews. The media will be given regular briefings which will give news of progress and planned work as the project proceeds.
