

Temporary Closure of Pukete Farm Park Boat Ramp Road and the Boat Ramp, Pukete Road

Hamilton City Council gives notice under the powers vested in it by the Reserves Act 1977 s.53 (1) (e) that the Boat Ramp Road and the boat ramp at Pukete Farm Park will be closed to all traffic, except emergency and official vehicles, from 6.00am Saturday 3rd October 2009 until 4.00pm Sunday 4th October 2009 for the purposes of a horse trial event.

There is an alternative boat ramp available in Roose Commerce Park, Grantham St, Hamilton.

No Parking at Waikato Stadium

There will be **NO-PARKING** restrictions in place on roads surrounding Waikato Stadium for the following event: **Air New Zealand Cup Waikato v North Harbour 1 October 2009, 7.35pm Kick off.**

The **NO-PARKING** restriction will be in place from 5.30am until 9.45pm in the following areas;

- Willoughby Street from Abbotsford Street to Richmond Street (Cemetery side only)
- Willoughby Street from Mill Street to Abbotsford Street (both sides)
- Abbotsford Street from Ulster Street to Willoughby Street (city side only)
- Abbotsford Street from Willoughby Street to Tristram Street (both sides)
- Tristram Street from Abbotsford Street to Mill Street (both sides)
- Seddon Road from Mill Street to Goldsmith Street (both sides)
- Seddon Road from Mill Street through to Rostrevor Street/Norton Road roundabout (both sides)
- Mill Street from Norton Road through to Willoughby Street (both sides)

Any vehicles contravening the **NO-PARKING** or **NO-STOPPING** restrictions will be liable to being ticketed and towed at the owners expense.
