Pursuant to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, public notice is hereby given that the Hamilton City Council, for the purpose of holding the Hamilton Christmas Parade will close on Sunday 13 December 2009, the following roads:

- Anglesea St between Liverpool St and Rostrevor St - between the hours of 7am and 4pm
- Anglesea St between Rostrevor St and Knox St - between the hours of 12pm and 4pm
- Knox St between Anglesea St and Victoria St - between the hours of 12pm and 5pm

No Parking

- 7am and 4pm - Anglesea St between Rostrevor St and Knox St
- 12pm and 5pm - Knox St between Anglesea St and Victoria St

It should also be noted that in the interests of public safety, the event organiser will be implementing traffic management and parking restrictions along the parade route.
