

Review of Operative Twin Stadia Development Plan and Reserve Management Plan

Hamilton City Council is about to undertake a review of the Operative Twin Stadia Development Plan and Reserve Management Plan pursuant to the Reserves Act 1977. The Operative Management Plan (adopted February 2007) details the vision, management objectives, event management policies, and the desired levels of service for Waikato Stadium and Seddon Park.

The scope of the review process is limited to considering the inclusion of Willoughby Park and Fred Jones Park into the Operative Management Plan, and considering changes to the purpose and use of the Mill Street field (previously referred to in the management plan as the No. 2 field). In all other respects the Operative Management Plan will remain unchanged, except for any other necessary minor amendments.

Members of the public and other interested parties are invited to make written suggestions on the proposed changes. These suggestions will be considered during the review of the Operative Management Plan. Following the initial suggestions period, a draft reviewed plan will be publicly advertised for submissions for a two month period.
